

St Andrews students from the Barty family

1. Rev. Thomas Barty

Son of Patrick Barty of Blairgowrie and Alison Souter, born Blairgowrie, March 1758; student at St Andrews 1775-83: matriculated into United College in February 1776; Bursar 1775, 1779 and 1781; Received Chancellor's Prize, 1778; Divinity student at St Mary's College 1778-83. Minister of Church of Scotland in Monzie, then Newtyle (1792-1815), then Bendochy (1815-32); married Agnes Kerr, died Bendochy, 1 August 1832

2. Rev. Patrick Barty

Eldest son of no. 1

Born Newtyle, 5 January 1798; student at St Andrews 1810-14: matriculated into United College in February 1811. Studied Divinity at Edinburgh, 1814-18. Minister of Church of Scotland in Ruthven (1823-70); died Ruthven, June 1870

3. Thomas Barty

Third son of no. 1

Born Newtyle, 3 April 1802; student at St Andrews 1814-15: matriculated into United College in April 1815. Student of Arts at Edinburgh 1820-21 and Law 1821-22. Practised Law in Perth, then solicitor and Procurator Fiscal in Dunblane from 1829; died Dunblane, November 1867

4. Rev. James Strachan Barty, DD

Fourth and youngest son of no. 1

Born Newtyle, 26 June 1805; student at St Andrews 1820-21: matriculated into United College in April 1821. Student of Arts at Edinburgh 1821-24 and Divinity 1824-28. Minister of Church of Scotland in Bendochy (1829-75). Awarded DD by St Andrews on 13 March 1852. Moderator of the General Assembly 1868; served as Clerk of the synod of Angus and Mearns; married Margaret Webster, died Bendochy, February 1875

5. Rev. Thomas Barty, MA, DD

Elder son of no. 4

Born Bendochy, February 1838; student at St Andrews 1851-59: matriculated into United College in February 1852 and graduated MA in 1856; Bursar 1852, 1856, 1858, 1859; Divinity student in St Mary's College 1856-59. Student of Divinity at Edinburgh 1859-60. Minister of Church of Scotland in Kirkcolm (1862-1900); Convenor of Small Livings Scheme of Church of Scotland; Clerk of the synod of Galloway. Awarded DD by St Andrews on 17 April 1890; died Kirkcolm, August 1900

6. James Webster Barty, LLD

Younger son of no. 4

Born Bendochy, November 1841; student at St Andrews 1855-58: matriculated into United College in February 1856. Student of law at Edinburgh, 1862-3. Awarded LL.D by St Andrews on 26 March 1897. Solicitor and Notary Public, Procurator Fiscal in Dunblane; President of the Incorporated Society of Law Agents of Scotland; President of the Association of Procurators Fiscal. Married Anne Moubray Boyd in 1866; died Dunblane, 23 May 1915

7. James Barty, MA, LLB

Eldest son of no. 6

Born Dunblane, 1 July 1868; student at St Andrews 1885-89: matriculated into United College in 1885; graduated MA on 18 April 1889. LLB (Edinburgh); solicitor and bank agent, Dunblane; Lord Provost of Dunblane; died Dunblane, 1942

8. Alexander Boyd Barty, MA, BSc, LLB

Second son of no. 6

Born Dunblane, 9 May 1873; attended Clifton Bank School in St Andrews; student at St Andrews 1888-1893: matriculated into United College in 1888, awarded Carstairs Prize in 1891 and graduated MA and BSc on 6 April 1893. LLB (Edinburgh); solicitor, Dunblane; married Christian Macadam Campbell in 1910; died Dunblane 1940

9. Thomas Patrick William Barty, BSc

Third son of no. 6

Born Dunblane, 10 March 1880; student at St Andrews 1896-7: matriculated into United College in 1896; BSc (Edinburgh) 1906; civil engineer in Sudan Civil Service; Awarded OBE in 1930 upon retiral, served as JP in Pitlochry from 1940; married (1) Mary Somerville Russel in 1817 and (2) Mary Theodora Donald in 1926; died Pitlochry, 1957

10. James Webster Barty, MA, LLB

Elder son of no. 8

Born Dunblane, 9 March 1912; student at St Andrews 1929-32: matriculated in October 1929; graduated MA in 1932. LLB (Edinburgh); solicitor, Dunblane; Secretary then President of the Scottish Law Agents Society; OBE 1980; married Elisabeth Beryl Roebuck in 1939; died Stirling, 4 February 1998

11. Dermont Campbell Barty, MA

Younger son of no. 8

Born Dunblane, 27 February 1914; student at St Andrews 1932-36: matriculated October 1932; graduated MA in 1936. Civil servant in India and Hong Kong; awarded OBE 1961; CBE 1968; married Anne Rosamund Hardy in 1940; died Stirling, 31 January 1985

12. James Boyd Barty, MA

Grandson of no. 6, elder son of John Boyd Barty (youngest son of no. 6)

Born 19 August 1929; student at St Andrews 1948-52: matriculated in October 1948; graduated MA in 1952; town planner; married Georgina Slater in 1964; died Cyprus, 23 September 2002

13. Elisabeth Barty, MA, PhD

Elder daughter of no. 10

Student at St Andrews 1959-63: matriculated in October 1959; graduated MA in 1963; PhD (Cantab); university lecturer

14. Leila Okasha, MA

Elder daughter of no. 13

Student at St Andrews 1988-92: matriculated in October 1988; graduated MA in 1992; PGCE (Edinburgh); Secondary school teacher

15. Mona Okasha, BSc, MSc, PhD

Younger daughter of no. 13

Student at St Andrews 1990-94: matriculated in October 1990; BSc (St Andrews) 1994; MSc (London); PhD (Bristol); University lecturer
